

Minutes of the meeting of the High Power Committee on RIDF held on 18/2/2017 under the Chairmanship of Sri V. B. Pyarelal, I.A.S. Additional Chief Secretary to the Govt. of Assam, Finance Department.

1. The meeting of the High Power Committee (HPC) on RIDF was held in the Conference Room of Finance Department, Block-F, Ground Floor to review the status of RIDF Projects and to streamline the pending drawals under the Chairmanship of Sri V. B. Pyarelal, I.A.S. Additional Chief Secretary to the Govt. of Assam, Finance Department. The meeting was attended by other officers of Finance department & the implementing departments, CGM, NABARD and other officials of NABARD. The list of members present in the meeting is appended herewith.
2. At the outset, the Chairman welcomed the members present and requested the Director, Finance (Economic Affairs) Department to explain the purpose of the meeting.
3. While explaining the objective of the meeting, the Director, Finance (Economic Affairs) Department indicated that the line departments concerned have so far submitted drawals for a total amount of Rs. 370.03 cr. only against the drawal limit amounting to Rs.1240.00 cr. fixed by the Ministry of Finance for RIDF during the current financial year leaving a huge gap for drawal. He also stated that non issuance of A/A by the line departments concerned in time as well as slow start of the works have delayed the entire implementation process and requested all departments concerned for taking proactive action in this regard.
4. After threadbare discussion, the members took the following decisions:
 - a) Tourism Department should inform NABARD and Finance Department regarding location change in three units of "Pay and Use Toilets" project under RIDF-XV so that NABARD can adjust the utilized amount of Rs. 161.30 lakh out of the total sanctioned amount of Rs.248.96 lakh (Mobilisation advance) under RIDF-XV and adjust the remaining balance of Rs. 87.66 lakh for other projects. The department submitted UC amounting Rs.161.30 Lakh to NABARD for the project. However, the UC could not be counted by NABARD since the department changed the location of the three Units without informing Finance Deptt. and NABARD. As a result, NABARD has not been able to adjust the mobilisation advance. As the RIDF-XV is closing in March, 2017, the department was asked to submit the details immediately to Finance as well as NABARD.
 - b) Soil Conservation, Fisheries and Cooperation Department were asked to issue A/A at the earliest to avoid deletion of the projects sanctioned under RIDF-XXI.
 - c) As regards continuation of two irrigation projects at Nagaon and Hojai under RIDF -XIX, Irrigation Department was asked to give formal information to Finance Department so that the same can be communicated to NABARD as the earlier HPC meeting decided to delete these two projects.

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- d) All line departments concerned were requested to initiate proactive action for submission of drawals at the earliest during 2016-17 so as to achieve the target during current financial year.
- e) As informed by NABARD, Fisheries, AH & Vety and Agriculture Department are admissible for submission of Mobilisation Advance proposals for the following amounts during 2016-17:

The departments were requested to expedite submission of Mobilisation Advance proposals immediately.

- (f) As regards the points raised by NABARD on the slow moving, non-starter projects and PCR submission, the Addl. Chief Secretary, Finance Department asked NABARD and all concerned implementing departments to reconcile the status as variation found in the records of NABARD and the departments concerned.
5. Lastly, Addl. Chief Secy., Finance Department requested all implementing line departments concerned for timely submission of UCs, drawal proposals, etc. to streamline the implementation process so as to achieve the targets stipulated for RIDF projects.
6. The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.

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
