No. FIF.22/2011/259. The Governor of Assam is pleased to notify the Commissioner & Secretary to the Govt. of Assam, Information & Technology Department as the **State Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) Coordinator** and **DBT Coordinator (Technical Support)** with immediate effect. The State DBT Coordinator shall act as the Nodal Officer for all DBT related matters of the State and will be primarily involve in Coordinating and liaisoning with the heads of various departments for effective implementation of DBT across schemes/programme of Central/State Govt. Heads of various departments shall work in tandem with the State DBT Coordinator with reference to setting up of goals and deadlines, receiving directives from the Centre, strategising Cell's operations etc. The State DBT Coordinator shall push different departments to work towards DBT implementation across schemes, supported by the State Advisory Board and on the basis of the mandates received from the Central Govt./Central Ministries.

The DBT Coordinator (Technical Support) will :

- (i) Facilitate all kinds of IT support for implementing DBT in different schemes implemented in the State (Central/States);
- (ii) Function as research unit in developing schemes/department-specific ICT applications which can capture data related to DBT in a more effective way.
- (iii) Be responsible for driving growth and achievement on all IT related indicators for successful implementation of DBT, like digitisation of data, streamlining beneficiary databases, and running de-duplication exercise, etc.
- (iv) Be responsible for interacting & liaisoning with all IT related stakeholders like NIC, third-party consultants, telecom service provides, etc.
- (v) Be responsible for enabling onboarding of all the schemes on the live MIS portal for capturing the information pertaining to DBT.


