OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Operational Guidelines on SASCI Part IX - Incentives to States for Efficiency in Financial Management for States and UTs with Legislature for FY 2026-27

Reference may be drawn to Public Finance - States Division, Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance's OM No 44(1)/PF-S/2026-27(CAPEX) dated 27.03.2026 regarding guidelines for Special Assistance to States for Capital Investment (SASCI), 2026-27.

2. Part IX of the referred OM specifies the guidelines on the incentives to States for efficiency in financial management for States and UTs with Legislature. An amount of Rs. 5,000 crore has been earmarked under this part and each State/UT shall be eligible for an incentive of up to Rs. 450 crore, subject to fulfillment of the qualifying criteria.

3. The key parameters that would be considered while assessing a State/UT with Legislature for fulfilment of the criteria for release of incentives under Part IX are detailed in Annexure A. All States/UTs with Legislature are requested to ensure strict adherence to these parameters to be considered for eligibility under SASCI Part IX for FY 2026-27.

4. A State/UT shall not be eligible for incentives under this part, even if it meets the qualifying and performance criteria, If the average time taken for forwarding of bills by the Drawing and Disbursing Officer (DDO) to their receipt in PFMS exceeds 7 days and if the State/UT is not regularly sharing data from the State treasury to PFMS for all components of Finance Commission Grants released to the State/UT.

5. The period applicable for assessment shall be 1st April 2026 to 15th December 2026.

6. All proposals should reach this vertical latest by 31st December 2026. The proposals along with the relevant supporting document should be emailed to h.atheli@nic.in (Joint Controller General of Accounts, GIFMIS-PFMS) and the physical copy may be sent to - Sh H. Assessment Parameters for SASCI Part IX - Incentives to States for Efficiency in Financial Management for States and UTs with Legislature for FY 2026-27

States/UTs shall be required to meet the following qualifying criteria under Part IX to be eligible for incentives:
