Sub: Sectoral Allocation under State Funding for Priority Development (SFPD) for the FY 2018-19 (includes State Own Priority Development (SOPD)/EAP/RIDF etc.)

Ref: This Department's Letter No. BB.404/2010/193, dated 29/11/2017

Sir,

Finance Department, based on the assessment made communicated by the T&D Department vide letter No.PDP.88/2017/15 dated: 09/01/2018 has worked out the State Funding for Priority Development (SFPD), 2018-19. As you are aware, the SFPD allocation includes State Own Priority Development (SOPD) previously called as State Plan schemes, Central Share and corresponding State Share of CSS and other GOI Schemes (such as NLCPR, NEC), EAP and RIDF.

Sectoral allocation under SFPD for 2018-19 (Maximum outer limit) is attached herewith at *Annexure-I* for submission of Grant-wise budget, by respective administrative Department, after taking approval of Minister-in-charge.

Grant-wise budget shall be submitted on FinAssam and the last date for <u>submission of the same is February 10th 2018.</u>

While preparing the above Grant-wise proposal as per the Sectoral allocations for SFPD attached, the <u>following guidelines</u> may be borne in mind.

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- 1. As you are aware, SOPD schemes are for priority areas of the State Government and should be utilized primarily for capital formation and hence warrant judicious planning and utilization of resources. Consequently, Administrative Departments are requested to follow a 'Zero-based Budgeting Approach' and re-visit every scheme approved in Budget 2017-18, evaluate the quality of their implementation and suggest provisions against existing or new schemes based on their relevance.
- 2. After estimating the State's resource position, the outer limit for sectoral allocations for 2018-19 have been increased by 10% across the board over the previous year. As mentioned earlier, Departments are requested to exercise utmost focus and propose schemes with judicious care and after proper examination. Further, they are requested to take a realistic view of the fund absorption capacity of their Department and propose allocations that they can utilize in the coming financial year.
- 3. Further, to give greater focus and attention to some of the flagship & major schemes of the Government, separate scheme-wise allocations, over and above the SOPD allocations, have been mentioned in *Annexure-II*
- 4. State Share under Centrally Sponsored, Externally Aided Projects and RIDF have been communicated based on funding pattern of the individual schemes as confirmed by the T&D and Finance (EA) Department. However, individual department may choose to modify the State share based on the estimates of CSS Schemes, post discussion with Finance Department.
- 5. As regards Central Share, in addition to allocation shown, if any department finds that Central Share amount previously allocated (till 2017-18) has not been drawn and now proposes to utilize in 2018-19, such amount may be proposed to be included in the budget with justification note along with the supporting documents of GOI. Proportionate State Share will also need to be proposed by the administrative department.
- 6. Further the sectoral allocations under RIDF & EAP are enclosed in *Annexure-III* and *Annexure-IV* respectively.
- 7. As regards the fund earlier allocated/ received under SPA by Planning Commission, if there is any unspent balance, the necessary budget provision may be proposed by the department in addition to the current SFPD allocation with a detailed justification note.
- 8. Other allocations such as Finance Commission recommendations etc. will be included in the budget by the Finance Department as per the approval of the competent authority in the State/Central Government.

It may be noted that the current allocation is the maximum possible and looking at the current resource position, no additional allocation is possible and the department SHALL ENSURE that the proposed expenditure is limited to the amount allocated against each department.

The allocations under TSP and SCSP and for Hill Areas will be communicated separately by the WPT&BC and the Hill Areas Departments.

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In case of any specific query, concerned officials along with the FA/Sr. FA concerned may be asked to meet Shri Kailash Karthik N, IAS, Joint Secretary (Budget) in this Department for immediate resolution of the issue.

Senior-Most Secretaries are kindly requested to monitor the process in their respective departments in order to ensure that innovative and productive scheme/ programmes are proposed as part of SFPD allocations so as to ensure that the investments lead to skill development, employment generation, growth and development within a time bound manner and in tune with SDG 2030. They are also requested to ensure that the proposals are submitted on FinAssam by 10th February, 2018 and within the approved sectoral allocations given.

Further, the Senior-Most Secretaries are kindly requested to ensure that the <u>Budget</u> <u>Speech is also submitted on FinAssam by 10th February, 2018</u>.
