Roles and responsibilities of the DBT PMU:

- (i) Co-ordinate with Centre/ Ministries and disseminating the directives to the respective department in the state.
- (ii) The unit will act as the focal point for implementation of all State owned/ centrally sponsored/ Central sector DBT Schemes in the state of Assam.
- (iii) Assist various departments of Govt. of Assam on DBT related indicators vis-àvis expected outcomes.
- (iv) In addition, the unit will also function as the research unit to explore possibility of using ICT for better service delivery across range of Govt. services in the state of Assam.
- (v) The unit will also monitor the DBT related IT platforms/ infrastructures of the

Role	Responsibilities
Team Leader	 Shall lead the team to implement and roll out DBT schemes in the state. Shall be responsible for monitoring, roll out and implementing the DIDS platform. Interacting with Scheme Owner Departments, IT related stakeholders, third parties, etc. for DIDS implementation and roll out in the state. Participate and organize department and society workshops on DIDS. Understand the needs of various scheme owner department regarding DBT schemes to define, plan and implement accordingly.
DBT Domain Expert	 Analyze the socio-economic impacts of DBT and DIDS efforts in the state. Running innovations in the state through pilots or/and experiment as per approval. Incentivizing DBT efforts in the state Training & Capacity building of state officials regarding DBT schemes and DIDS and document the progress and impacts on that. Supervise in the development of IT platform whenever the need arises.

Banking Expert	 Organize and participate in State Level Banker' Committee (SLBC) and State Level Financial Implementation Committee (SLIC) and train the state officials as per requirement. Organize exposure visits for the state officials in DBT progressive states for familiarizing them with model practices. Conducting benchmarking studies on Best Practices and developing roadmap to incorporate those practices in the state operations.
IT Support Associate	 Analyze the data of various DBT schemes related to the Finance (IF) Department. Maintaining a database of beneficiaries in respect of the various schemes related to the Finance (IF) Department. Compilation of the data of various schemes related to the Finance (IF) Department for report. Monitor and plan End to End digitization of state DBT schemes. Supervise and monitor the development of IT platform whenever the need arises. Training & Capacity building of state officials regarding DBT schemes (IT) and DIDS.
